This week, Darryl Kapeyi from Year two passed by school to see his teacher and we had a small chat with him.

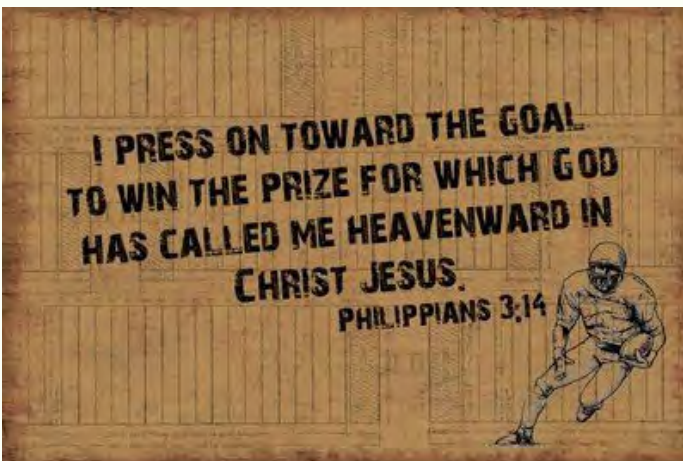


A chat with Darryl, Year Two

- Term 2 will begin on Monday, 22nd November, 2021.

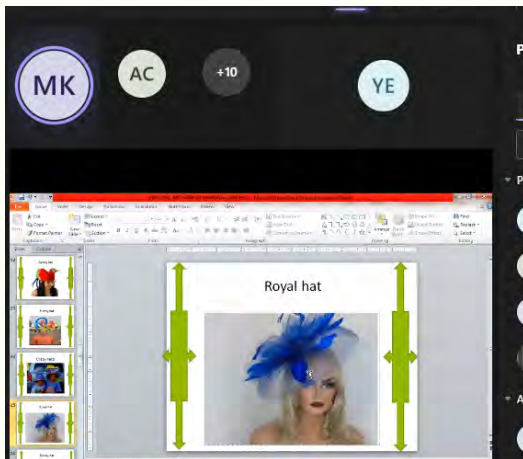

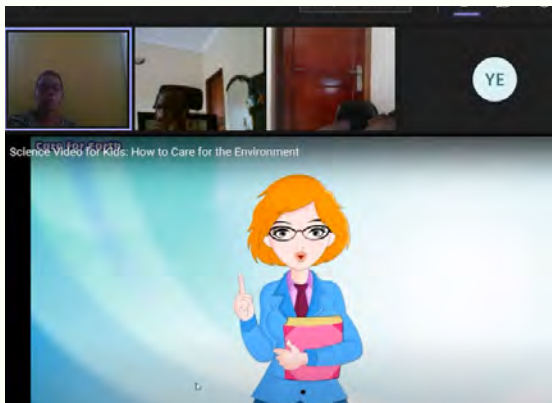
YEAR ONE

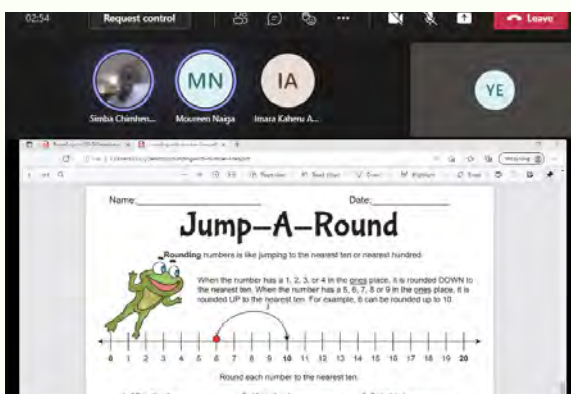
YEAR TWO
